River Road Park District takes great pride in maintaining the grounds throughout the district, the restrictions below are in place to help prevent damage to these areas.

Permit: Free permit on file is required before the use of metal detection occurs.

Special Conditions and Restrictions:

- Extraction and removal of objects located with a metal detecting device should be conducted only with a hand implement e.g. small hand trowel.
- Holes are limited to a depth of six (6) inches and a diameter of six (6) inches.
- Holes must be filled and surface returned to original condition, or as close as possible, (leave no damage at all).
- Any trash or debris generated by activities should be disposed of in a trash receptacle or taken off-site.
- Damage to or removal of park equipment e.g. (irrigation system) is prohibited and must be reported to River Road Park Staff immediately.
- River Road Park District reserves the right to revoke or restrict the use of metal detection on district property when deemed necessary.
